ПРОГРАММА ВСТУПИТЕЛЬНОГО ИСПЫТАНИЯ
по профильному вступительному испытанию
«Современный иностранный язык»

Калининград
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Программа вступительных испытаний разработана для поступающих в БФУ им. И.Канта на базе среднего профессионального образования.

Вступительный экзамен проводится в форме электронного онлайн тестирования на портале тестирования БФУ им. И. Канта и/или письменного теста.

Вступительный экзамен включает в себя следующие задания:

1. Выполнение тестовых лексико-грамматических заданий по иностранному языку.
2. Чтение текста и выполнение сопровождающих его заданий по иностранному языку: соотнесение, заполнение пропусков.

Тематика заданий соответствует содержанию программы по иностранному языку среднеобразовательной школы.

Общее время - 60 минут.

В него входит время выполнения тестовых лексико-грамматических заданий и заданий по чтению.

Структура и форма вступительного экзамена

Вступительный экзамен по иностранному языку (английский) проводится в письменной форме и представляет собой выполнение

- лексико-грамматических тестовых заданий по выбранному иностранному языку;
- заданий по чтению;

Лексико-грамматические тестовые задания разработаны в соответствии с требованиями программы средней общеобразовательной школы и включают в себя следующие задания:

- множественный выбор: выбор слов из ряда предложенных, наиболее точно соответствующие конкретному контексту по принципу коллокации, управления глаголов предложениями, лексической сочетаемости и т.д.;
- словообразование: трансформация слов из одной части речи в другую на основе применения правил префиксации, суффиксации и использования окончаний, а также изменение корня слова.

Задания на чтение разработаны в соответствии с требованиями программы средней общеобразовательной школы и включают в себя следующие задания:

- соотнесение: чтение текста на иностранном языке и соотнесение заголовков с параграфами текста;
- заполнение пропусков: чтение текста на иностранном языке и заполнение пропусков текста наиболее подходящими отрывками из предложенных.

Критерии оценивания:

1. Верно выполнено 80% и более тестовых заданий – 100 баллов
2. Верно выполнено 79% - 60 %тестовых заданий – 70-89 баллов
3. Верно выполнено 59% - 40% тестовых заданий – 50 – 69 баллов
4. Верно выполнено 20% - 39% тестовых заданий – 30 – 49 баллов
5. Верно выполнено 19% и менее% тестовых заданий – 0 баллов
