REGULATIONS ACT of the International Philosophy Olympiad

1. General provisions

1.1. The Regulations Act is drawn under the Statute on the International Philosophy Olympiad (hereinafter referred to as the International Olympiad) and approved by the Organizing Committee of the International Olympiad.

2. Registration of Participants

2.1. **From the 25th of July to the 05th of September 2022** all participants of the International Olympiad are to register and fill in the participant application form on the official website of the International Olympiad.

3. The theme of the International Olympiad

3.1 The theme of the International Olympiad is determined by the Programme Committee.

The themes of the tasks correspond to the following "workshops sections":

- Modern Neurophilosophy and issue of AI.
- Critical thinking, logic, and argumentation theory
- Ethics in the era of digital reality.
- Philosophical anthropology
- Russia's philosophy and intellectual culture
- Interaction points between philosophy and theology: history and contemporary times.

4. Form and procedure of the first stage of the International Olympiad.

4.1. The first stage will be held online on **the 6th of September, 2022. From 12.00 to 15.00 Moscow time (GMT+3).**

4.2. Participants perform the task in their account on the official website of the International Olympiad.

5. The evaluation of the works submitted by the participants during the first stage of the International Olympiad.

5.1. The winners of the first stage are chosen based on their score (50 points maximum). Points are attributed according to the criteria of plagiarism, relevance, cogency, and compliance with the theme of the International Olympiad. The number of winners of the first stage must not exceed 25 percent of the total number of participants.

5.2. The results of the first stage of the International Olympiad are summarized at the Jury Panel meeting. The document that consolidates the final results of the first stage is the meeting minutes of the Jury Panel signed by the chairperson of the Jury Panel and all members of the Jury Panel. The Organizing Committee of the Competition shall be provided with the meeting minutes no later than the 25th of September 2022.

5.3. The results of the first stage will be published on the website of the International Olympiad no later than the 30th of September, 2022.

6. Form and procedure of the second stage of the International Olympiad

6.1. The second stage of the International Olympiad will take place in person.

6.2. The winners of the first stage of the International Olympiad are entitled to participate in the second stage and will be officially notified of it and invited to do so.

6.3. The second (in-person) stage of the International Olympiad will have two categories: original works on the theme determined by the Organizing Committee and presentation of the projects on the promotion of modern achievements in the field of philosophy.

7. Evaluation of the tasks for the second (in-person) stage.

7.1. The second (in-person) stage involves the public presentation of the produced work that will take place on the 22-23rd of November 2022 at the Immanuel Kant Baltic Federal University.

7.2. On the 24th of November, 2022, the Jury Panel will evaluate the produced works and presentation of the projects of the second stage

7.3. The results of evaluation of the works produced by the participants of the second stage of the International Olympiad are entered into the final score sheet.

7.4. The final score sheet shall be published no later than 15.00 on the 24th of November.

7.5. After the appeals will have been considered the final results of the Olympiad will be published on the 25th of November.

8. Procedure for summing up the results of the International Olympiad

8.1. The winners of the International Olympiad are determined based on their scores for the first and second stages. Points are attributed according to the

criteria of plagiarism, relevance, cogency, and compliance with the theme of the Olympiad. The maximum number of points for both stages is 100.

8.2. The results of the International Olympiad are summarized at the Jury Panel meeting after the members of the Jury Panel sign the final score sheets. The document that consolidates the final results is the meeting minutes of the Jury Panel signed by the chairperson of the Jury Panel as well as by all members of the Jury Panel. The meeting minutes are handed over to the Organizing Committee of the International Olympiad for determining the winners with the highest number of points.

8.3. The number of the winners and prize-winners of the International Olympiad shall not exceed 20 percent of the total number of participants in the second stage of the International Olympiad.

8.4. The list of the winners will be published on the official website of the International Olympiad no later than the 25th of November, 2022.

8.5. The Appeal Commission is considering appeals under the procedure specified in the Statute of the Olympiad.

9. Final results of the Olympiad and the Award Ceremony.

9.1. The winners of the Olympiad are determined based on the number of points.

9.2. The winners are awarded certificates and valuable prizes.

9.3. The Award Ceremony for the winners of the Olympiad will take place on the 25th of November 2022 in Kaliningrad.
