Publication of conference materials

The Conference Program Committee will recommend selected presentations for publication in the special issues of the Russian national journals "Environmental safety of coastal and shelf zones of the sea" (included in the list of the Higher Attestation Commission, RSCI impact factor is 0.756), "Oceanological Research" (included in the list of Higher Attestation Commission, RSCI impact factor is 0.370) and International Journal "Baltica" (indexed in WoS and Scopus).

Visa

For most foreigners, it is essential to obtain a Russian visa. The Conference Organizing Committee may prepare visa support letters by **January 15, 2022** (upon request).

Registration fee

Instruction for authors

The applicant can submit to the collection of conference materials no more than two materials as the first author. Contribution as a co-author is not limited.

The text (see the template below) must be submitted in electronic form (Word editor, margins - 25 mm on all sides, font Times New Roman, size 14, single-spaced, justified).

In the upper left corner, there is a thematic UDC number (for the foreign participants, it will be assigned by organizers). On the following line - the title of the contribution in the centre in capital letters in bold without abbreviations. Below in the centre, separated by commas, the full names of the authors (for example, Petrov S.A.) are written in bold italics, with superscript numbers indicating the subsequent affiliation with the organization. Further, the organization represented by the author, city, country, email address should be listed under the authors' full names, sequentially, following the affiliation of the article's authors, left alignment.

The following line contains keywords in italics.

The total volume of materials should not exceed three pages; any graphic material is allowed (in shades of grey, good resolution, at least 300 dpi), location - anywhere in the text, size of the minor designation - 10 point size. All captions within a figure should be in English. Translation of the figure captions to Russian will be added by organizers.

Footnotes are paginated, automatic, by numbers (size 12). Paragraph indent - 1.25 cm, automatic, not just the Space key. Use automatic word hyphenation on lines. There is no page numbering.

Place the list references at the end of the text in alphabetical order without indentation. Links to used literature should be inserted in the text in square brackets in the form [Surname, year] or [Surname et al., year] in the case of more than two authors.

The file with the contribution must be named with the first author's surname. If the first author submits two materials, a sequential number is indicated after the author's surname (for example, Petrov1.docx, Petrov2.docx).

The organizing committee reserves the right to select materials and partially edit them, taking into account the conference's theme.
